Vehicles can be driven up to the set-up area and items dropped off and then the vehicle will need to be moved back to our parking prior to gates opening to the public(9:30am on Saturdays and 12:00pm on Sundays *Easter Egg Drop Friday 9 & Saturday 9), to ensure the safety of our guests and animals. All vehicles must be moved out of the vendor area and into the parking lot prior to Alpha and Omega Opening the gates.

Space: The cost includes a 10' wide space. You will need to provide your tent and supplies. We will provide the space only. The Vendor will need to bring a generator if power is needed. Alpha & Omega Corn Maze does not provide power. This generator cannot be loud and if determined that the noise is too loud, you will be asked to turn the generator off.

The reservation fee will be Paid via Square invoice and will be emailed once your application is received and approved. The fee is nonrefundable. If we do not open due to inclement weather, we will work with you to reschedule to another day and slot. Your spot is not reserved until the vendor fee is paid.
